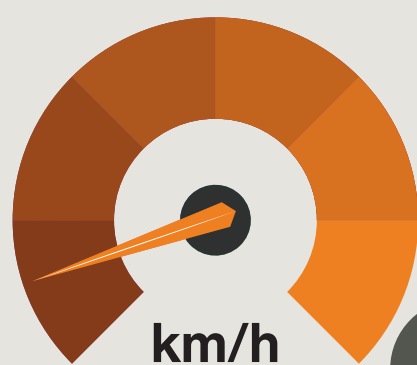


Working with machines or vehicles

To stay safe when using machinery:

Keep your vehicle at a safe speed – even a slow speed can cause serious injury or death



Look out for other workers while you are driving or using machinery



Only use machinery that you are trained and licensed to use



Make sure you are visible when working near machinery



Wear a seatbelt, even if you are travelling slowly



Be aware of the ground you are driving on, a bumpy road can lead to injury



Be aware of machinery operating around you – do not walk directly in front or behind any machinery in use



Report damaged or unsafe machinery to your supervisor - do not use it until it is safe
