

Personal protective equipment

To protect yourself on a farm you need to wear, when appropriate:

Sturdy items of clothing – durable top and pants, steel capped boots that cover your toes and thick gloves



Hardware – helmets, face mask, protective eyewear and boot covers



Bright clothing – hi-vis vests



Sun protective clothing – hats, a top with a collar and sunscreen



Cold protective clothing – waterproof clothing, beanie, gloves, thick warm clothing



Your employer needs to provide you with personal protective equipment and clothing to help keep you safe at work. If it is not available, please speak up.
